FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 2206 - SB 2224

May 22, 2020

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Reduces the period of time, from five business days to three business days, by which the Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) must publish on its website any final orders by an administrative judge or the Tennessee Board of Water Quality, Oil, and Gas.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (017688):** Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Prohibits the TDEC from requiring any permit, inspection, or review or approval of plans for the construction, installation, or modification of any land application system authorized pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 69-3-105(1).

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

**Unchanged from the original fiscal note.**

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Based on information provided by the TDEC, the bill as amended will result in TDEC no longer being required to review certain construction plans for land application systems.
- The Departments' review of such constructions plans does not impact the necessity to acquire an operating permit or the current cost of such permit; therefore, this legislation is estimated to have no significant impact on state government.
