SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Decreases, from 14 days to 3 days, the period of time in which a person offered a teaching position is required to accept or reject an employment offer in writing to the local board of education or director of schools.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (018231): Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Changes, from 14 days to an unspecified time frame determined by the local board or director of schools, the number of days of day within which a person must accept or reject an offer of employment for a teaching position. Effective August 1, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Under current law, upon receipts of the employment notification, a person has 14 days to accept or reject, in writing, the offered employment. Therefore, the proposed legislation will authorize the local board or director of schools to determine the timeframe within which a person must accept or reject an offer of employment for a teaching position.
- Local education agencies will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
