FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1008 - SB 1247

June 8, 2020

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires the Department of Education (DOE) to publish on its website the list of art supplies certified nontoxic by the Arts and Creative Institute.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (018359): Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Requires that a school that has been placed in the Achievement School District (ASD) to remain in the ASD until the school is authorized to return to the school's LEA. Requires the Commissioner of the Department of Education (DOE) to develop a transition plan for the purpose of planning the return of schools in the Achievement School District (ASD) to the Local Education Agencies (LEAs) from which the schools were removed no earlier than the 2024-25 school year. Requires the Commissioner of DOE to submit the plan developed to the Education Committees of the Senate and the House of Representatives by January 1, 2021.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- DOE will be able to develop a plan in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact on state or local operations.
