FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1991 - SB 2008

June 12, 2020

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Authorizes a business, firm, or other person transacting business from a permanent location to provide at least two specially marked parking spaces exclusively for the use of women who are pregnant or any person with a child under two years old, if properly marked by a sign.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (018206): Adds a whereas clause to state an expectant mother is carrying a unique human being in her womb whose life and health should be protected.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Some businesses currently have designated parking spaces for expectant mothers.
- Parking lots owned by state and local government are not affected by the language of this legislation.
- Authorizing businesses, firms, and other persons transacting business from a permanent location to provide at least two specially marked parking spaces exclusively for the use of women who are pregnant or any person with a child under two years old will not have a significant fiscal impact on state or local government. Any impact will be borne by private entities.
