FISCAL NOTE

HB 64 – SB 1435

February 7, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Commerce and Labor Committee of the Senate, the Insurance Committee of the House of Representatives, the Finance, Ways and Means Committee of the Senate and the Finance, Ways and Means Committee of the House of Representatives to review the Access Tennessee Act of 2006, and recommend any necessary changes to the Governor and the General Assembly no later than February 1.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 56-7-2914, the committees currently review and recommend these changes to the Governor and the General Assembly.
- It is estimated that requiring the committees to submit their findings by February 1 will have no fiscal impact on state or local government.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Requiring the specified committees to review and report any recommended changes to the Access Tennessee Act of 2006 will have no impact on jobs or commerce in Tennessee.
