**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 86 - SB 167**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the state, any agency, institution, and political subdivision thereof to post previously adopted written policies concerning electronic mail communications to the applicable entity's website.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Tenn. Code Ann. § 10-7-512(a) requires the state or any agency, institution, or political subdivision thereof that operated or maintained an electronic mail communication system to adopt a written policy on any monitoring of the communications and the circumstances under which it would be conducted by July 1, 2000.
- The proposed language would require such entities to post such written policies to the entity's website, if one exists.
- Any fiscal impact to state or local government entities associated with the posting of such policies to current websites is estimated to be not significant.
