SUMMARY OF BILL: Adds the Health Committee of the House of Representatives and the Health and Welfare Committee of the Senate to the list of committees any entity under the Division of Health Related Boards is required to submit reports on vacancies.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 63-1-143(a), any entity under the Division of Health Related Boards that has received sufficient information to make an informed decision to fill a vacancy and still has more than one vacant position for longer than 180 days, is required to report why such vacancies have not been filled to the Government Operations Committee of the House of Representatives, and the Government Operations Committee of the Senate.
- Adding the Health Committee of the House of Representatives and the Health and Welfare Committee of the Senate to the list of committees to receive vacancy reports will not have a significant impact on the procedures or processes of the Division of Health Related Boards or the Department of Health; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
