HB 131 - SB 78

January 28, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Urges the Department of Revenue (DOR) to study the enforcement of disabled parking violations of Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-21-108 and local ordinances and resolutions relative to parking privileges for persons with disabilities. The DOR, assuming performance of the study, is required to report its findings and recommendations to the Transportation and Safety Committee of the Senate and the Transportation Committee of the House of Representatives, which shall include any available data regarding violations and recommendations on enforcement.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Assumptions:

- The DOR will complete the study that is urged by the proposed legislation.
- According to the DOR, the study can be performed utilizing existing resources without a significant increase in state expenditures or reduced reversion.
