HB 172 - SB 210

February 4, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from three to five business days, the amount of time prior to an annual meeting which a mail ballot concerning the election of members of a board of directors for a rural electric cooperative must be delivered to the cooperative.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Increasing by two business days the time period which mail ballots must be delivered to cooperatives will not result in any significant impact to state or local government.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The proposed legislation will not result in any significant impact to jobs or commerce in Tennessee.
