SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from 18 to 25 years, the age requirement for an individual to be appointed as a delegate or alternate delegate to an Article V convention proposing amendments to the Constitution of the United States.

- Increasing the age requirement for delegates to an Article V convention will not result in any significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
