**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 205 - SB 242**

February 8, 2019

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires an institution of higher education to classify a student who is the spouse or a dependent of a service member as an in-state student for tuition purposes if the student has been transferred out of Tennessee as a result of military orders.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Based on information from the University of Tennessee System this legislation will codify the current practice, therefore, there would not be a significant impact on tuition revenue.
- The proposed legislation does not change the definition of residency status; therefore, there will not be a significant fiscal impact to locally governed institutions.
- Based on information provided by the Tennessee Board of Regents, any fiscal impact to the community or technical colleges is estimated to be not significant.
