HB 282 – SB 392

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires any legislation which creates or modifies licensure, certification, or registration requirements for occupational and professional groups be referred for review to the Government Operations Committee by the Speaker of each house. For the purposes of the review, the Government Operations Committee of each house is considered an appropriate, but not exclusive, standing committee for such legislation. The consideration of the Government Operations Committee as the standing committee is subject to the authority of the respective Speakers of each house to refer legislation to legislative committees.

Assumption:

- Referring legislation to an existing standing committee will have no significant fiscal impact on state government or the expenditures of the General Assembly.
