FISCAL NOTE

HB 293

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Board of Optometry within the Division of Health Related Boards (HRB) to notify the chairs of the Health Committee of the House of Representatives and the Senate Health and Welfare Committee within 30 days if a member of the Board is removed from office.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Passage of this legislation will have no effect on the procedures or processes of the HRB or the Department of Health; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all health related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Board of Optometry had an annual surplus of \$23,883 in FY16-17, an annual surplus of \$44,063 in FY17-18, and a cumulative reserve balance of \$731,534 on June 30, 2018.
