HB 335 - SB 386

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires emergency calls, transmissions, and recordings of an emergency communications district and emergency communications board to be kept confidential except in certain circumstances.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation would make 911 calls, transmissions, and recordings confidential except for use by law enforcement, fire, medical, rescue, dispatching, or other emergency services. Such recordings may be released with the written consent of the caller captured on the call.
- Requiring such recordings be treated as confidential except in certain circumstances will not result in any significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
