SUMMARY OF BILL: Decreases, from 60 to 45 days, the time period after a hearing regarding a violation of the Tennessee Meat and Poultry Inspection Act, which the Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Agriculture (DOA) has to issue an order pursuant to the hearing.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Reducing the number of days for the Commissioner of DOA to issue an order pursuant to a violation hearing will not significantly impact the expenditures or revenue of the state or its agencies.
