HB 374 – SB 1439

SUMMARY OF BILL: Changes, from December 31 to December 15, the date by which the Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) must produce its report of all employers that failed to obtain workers' compensation coverage or qualify as a self-insured employer during the previous fiscal year.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Any fiscal impact resulting from the requirement for the BWC to produce the report 16 days earlier is estimated to be not significant.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Changing by 16 days the date by which the BWC must file a report will not have any impact on commerce or jobs in Tennessee.
