HB 385 - SB 416

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Commissioner of the Department of Commerce and Insurance (DCI) to conduct a study determining the amount of insurance policies providing neurological and autism spectrum disorder treatment benefits in the state. Requires the Commissioner to submit the report to the Insurance Committee of the House of Representatives and the Commerce and Labor Committee of the Senate by January 1, 2020.
