FISCAL NOTE

HB 399 - SB 1261

February 14, 2019

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires each local board of education and charter school governing body to develop a code of conduct that describes the types of behavior expected from all persons entering school grounds. Requires the code of conduct to include the consequences of a person's failure to adhere to the behavioral standards and that the code of conduct be posted on the website for the school, local education agency (LEA), or charter school governing body. Requires copies of the code of conduct to be distributed to all teachers, students, parents, and guardians.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Each local board of education, charter school governing body, and LEA will be able to comply with the proposed legislation using existing resources.
- Each local board of education, charter school governing body, and LEA will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- Any expenditures related to distributing the code of conduct will be not significant.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
