FISCAL NOTE

HB 511 – SB 1067

February 26, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Establishes that defenses to prosecution for criminal trespass, as found in Tenn. Code Ann. § 57-3-413, are not available to a person between 18 and 21 years of age, is located on the premises of a retail package store, is visibly intoxicated or otherwise disruptive, and has been asked to leave the premises of such store.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Criminal trespass is a Class C misdemeanor.
- This legislation is not expected to result in a significant increase in Class C misdemeanor offenses committed by the public.
- There will not be a sufficient number of prosecutions for state or local government to experience any significant increase in revenue or expenditures.
