FISCAL NOTE

HB 536 - SB 1492

February 9, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requests the Department of Safety (DOS) to conduct a study on the number of motor vehicle accidents reported to the Department in the previous four years that resulted in serious bodily injury or property damage exceeding \$1,000 and involving a malfunctioning airbag or other restraint system component and to submit the results to the Transportation Committees of the General Assembly by February 1, 2020.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Based on information provided by DOS, performing a study concerning the number of motor vehicles accidents that resulted in serious bodily injury or property damage exceeding \$1,000 and involving a malfunctioning airbag or other restraint system component can be completed with existing resources.
- DOS can execute this study within regular business hours utilizing existing staff; therefore, there will not be any significant increase in state expenditures.
