FISCAL NOTE

HB 566 - SB 538

February 26, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Department of Education (DOE) to report the total amount of education funding allocated, for the preceding school year, to each state agency responsible for the education of a child in state custody, to the Chairs of the Education Committee of the Senate and the Education Committee of the House of Representatives by October 1 of each year.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- DOE will be able to comply with the proposed legislation using existing resources without a significant increase in state expenditures.
- DOE will be able to amend its policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
