FISCAL NOTE

HB 573 – SB 1091

SUMMARY OF BILL: Deletes the antiquated requirement for the Controlled Substance Database Advisory Committee (Committee) to develop a form, no later than August 1, 2010, that healthcare providers may choose to use to make reports regarding unlawful attempts to obtain controlled substances.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation removes the outdated requirement for the Committee to create the form no later than August 1, 2010.
- Passage of this legislation will not have a significant impact on the procedures or processes of the Department of Health; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
