**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 592 - SB 591**

March 28, 2019

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Changes, from October 1 to September 1, the date by which the Office of Coordinated School Health in the Department of Education (DOE) must provide an annual report to the Education Committees of the House of Representatives and the Education Committee of the Senate. Requires, rather than authorizes, a local education agency (LEA) to implement a coordinated school health program developed by the Commissioner of DOE and in consultation with the Department of Health (DOH).

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- DOE, LEAs, and DOH will be able to comply with the proposed legislation using existing resources without a significant increase in expenditures.
- DOE, LEAs, and DOH will be able to amend its policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
- No impact to the BEP funding formula.
