**FISCAL NOTE**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Decreases, from 30 days to 15 business days, the time in which members of the Corn Promotion Board (CPB) are required to meet following their appointment to the CPB. Decreases, from 30 days to 15 business days, the time in which the initial Chair of the CPB is required to notify the Government Operations Committees of the CPB's existence.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 43-29-115(d), members of the CPB shall not be compensated but are eligible for reimbursement of travel expenses.
- Decreasing the number of days for either of these timelines will not have a significant impact on the number of times the CPB will meet. As a result, any impact on CPB expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
