FISCAL NOTE

HB 696 - SB 1496

February 12, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Exempts farm tractors and implements of husbandry from the requirement that slow-moving vehicles pull off certain roadways.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-8-123, where passing is unsafe because of traffic in the opposite direction or other conditions, a slow-moving vehicle, behind which five or more vehicles are formed in line, shall turn or pull off the roadway wherever sufficient area exists to do so safely, in order to permit vehicles following it to proceed. Funeral processions and school buses shall not apply.
- Including farm tractors and implements of husbandry as an exception to this statute will have no significant impact on state or local revenue or expenditures.
- There will not be a sufficient change in the number of violations for state or local government to experience any significant change in revenue or expenditures.
