SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires, on or before January 1, 2020, the Tennessee Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations (TACIR) to perform a study regarding the inspection, testing, and quarantine of property where fentanyl or its analogues are found within the state and report its findings to the members of the House and Senate Health Committees.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Assumption:

- According to TACIR, the required study can be accomplished utilizing existing staff and resources; therefore, any impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
