HB 832 - SB 1045

February 27, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits persons from standing or conducting any activity in, or in proximity to, the median of a state highway without first obtaining permission from the Department of Transportation. Establishes first violation of such as a warning citation and subsequent offenses as a Class C misdemeanor.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- According to information provided by the Administrative Office of the Courts, any increase in the caseloads of the court system can be absorbed with the existing judicial resources.
- There will not be a sufficient number of prosecutions for state or local government to experience any significant increase in revenue or expenditures.
