HB 846 - SB 892

SUMMARY OF BILL: Changes, from 10 days to 10 business days, the time period within which a director of schools must notify the chief of the appropriate law enforcement agency after the director of schools has authorized a person to carry or possess a firearm on school property.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Local education agencies (LEAs) will be able to comply with the proposed legislation using existing resources.
- LEAs will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to state or local government.
