HB 853 - SB 715

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires consent of the applicable county legislative body prior to ratification of certain annexation resolutions.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Tennessee Code Annotated § 6-51-104(d), authorizes a municipality to propose annexation of certain noncontiguous territory by resolution if the affected property owners provide written consent.
- The proposed legislation would also require the consent of the applicable county legislative body prior to ratification of the annexation resolution.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 6-51-104(d)(4), any annexing resolution must include a plan of services which was prepared in cooperation with the county, and the municipality and county must enter into an interlocal agreement to provide emergency services for certain properties.
- Requiring consent of the applicable county legislative body prior to ratification of the annexing resolution is not anticipated to result in a decrease in the number of annexing resolutions which are ratified.
- Any vote required of the local legislative body will be conducted at a regularly scheduled meeting; therefore, any fiscal impact to local government is estimated to be not significant.
