**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 892 - SB 833**

February 13, 2019

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Changes, from January 31 to January 15, the deadline by which the Department of Health (DOH) must provide the report on the aggregate results of all Body Mass Index (BMI) screenings performed in the previous calendar year to the Governor's Office, the Speaker of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- DOH will be able to comply with the proposed legislation using existing resources.
- DOH will be able to amend its policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to the Department of Education, the Basic Education Program, or local education agencies.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
