FISCAL NOTE

HB 893 - SB 834

February 12, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends, from two to four weeks, the time period following a written notice to a local board of education from which the Commissioner of the Department of Education (DOE) may withhold and declare forfeited state school funds due to a failure to comply with or enforce the census or compulsory school attendance laws.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Extending by two weeks the amount of time the Commissioner can withhold or declare funds forfeited will not change the amounts of funding withheld from or forfeited by a local school district.
- DOE and local education agencies (LEAs) will be able to comply with the proposed legislation using existing resources.
- DOE and LEAs will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
