HB 938 - SB 794

March 15, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends, from 30 to 45 days, the initial student application period that a charter school authorized by the Achievement School District (ASD) is required to conduct.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Charter schools authorized by the ASD will be able to comply with proposed legislation using existing resources without a significant increase in expenditures.
- Charter schools authorized by the ASD will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
- No change to the Basic Education Program.
