FISCAL NOTE

HB 952 - SB 808

March 9, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Transfers, from the State Board of Education (SBE) to the Department of Education (DOE), authority and responsibility to accept and administer federal funds for the purpose of promoting public education and for federal appropriations made for career and technical education. Updates and deletes language related to the administration of state rehabilitation services and transfers responsibility from SBE to DOE.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation will codify current practice.
- SBE and DOE will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No change to the Basic Education Program.
- No significant impact to federal funding.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
