**HB 1013 - SB 1446**

February 11, 2019

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Effective January 1, 2020, requires equine professionals to post a limited liability warning sign by each primary entrance and exit used by general public.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Any impact resulting from this legislation will be borne by private entities.
- The proposed legislation will have no significant fiscal impact to state or local government.

**IMPACT TO COMMERCE:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumption:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 44-20-105(a), equine professionals are currently required to post and maintain limited liability warning signs in locations where members of the public participate in equine activities. The proposed legislation will have no significant fiscal impact to equine professionals or participants of equine activities.
