FISCAL NOTE

HB 1109 – SB 1070

March 26, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Commissioner of the Department of Health (DOH) to study issues related to healthcare access and healthcare status of populations affected by the implementation of Chapter 1043 of the Public Acts of 2016. Requires the Commissioner to report the findings and any recommendations arising out of the study to the Health Committee of the House of Representatives and the Health and Welfare Committee of the Senate, on or before January 15, 2020.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Chapter 1043 of the Public Acts of 2016 made various changes to provisions governing certificates of need.
- The Commissioner of the DOH will conduct the required study utilizing existing resources without an increase in expenditures; therefore, any fiscal impact is not significant.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Requiring the Commissioner of the DOH to conduct a study related to healthcare access and healthcare status of populations affected by the implementation of Chapter 1043 of the Public Acts of 2016 will have no significant impact on commerce or jobs in Tennessee.
