**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 1132 - SB 1205**

February 12, 2019

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Clarifies that certain requests for background checks are authorized to be made through electronic means.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 38-6-106(a), any request for investigative records by the Governor, Speaker of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, or the Supreme Court Chief Justice is required to be in writing, signed by the respective requestor, and specifically state the reasons for such request.
- Any fiscal impact resulting from authorizing such requests to be submitted electronically is estimated to be not significant.
