HB 1237 - SB 1274

March 14, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires a judge, or a jury coordinator delegated by a judge, to excuse a practicing physician from jury duty upon request, if provided documentation verifying that the individual is licensed to practice medicine.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Any addition in workload for the courts, as a result of this legislation, can be accommodated within existing resources and personnel.
- Requiring a practicing physician be excused from jury duty upon request, if provided documentation, will not result in a significant increase to state or local expenditures.
