**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 1412 - SB 1423**

March 15, 2019

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Extends, from 180 to 210 days, the time period after assuming office that a newly-elected judge or appointed judge or chancellor is authorized to practice law in order to wind up the judge or chancellor's practice.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumption:

- Based on information provided by the Administrative Office of the Courts, any impact to the court system resulting from extending the number of days a newly-elected judge or appointed judge or chancellor is authorized to practice law in order to wind up his or her practice is estimated to be not significant.
