FISCAL NOTE

HB 1662

SUMMARY OF BILL: Deletes the requirement for a defendant that pleads guilty or is found guilty of a domestic violence offense to complete an affidavit of firearms dispossession form and to return such form to the court in which the defendant was convicted when all firearms have been lawfully dispossessed.

Requires the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) to develop a domestic violence offense firearm notification form and to post such form on the AOC website. Requires a defendant charged with a domestic violence offense to sign such form prior to the court accepting a guilty plea.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Based on information provided by the AOC, any impact resulting from the development, drafting, and posting of a domestic violence offense firearm notification form will be accomplished utilizing existing resources; therefore, any fiscal impact to AOC is estimated to be not significant.
- Any impact to the court system is estimated to be not significant.
