**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 1836**

January 28, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Adds a representative from the Tennessee Nurses Association, a representative from the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, and the Executive Director of the Tennessee Commission on Aging and Disability as voting members of the Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementia Advisory Council (Council).

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- The Council currently consists of 2 legislative members and 11 non-legislative members, for a total of 13 members.
- The proposed legislation would add 3 additional non-legislative members, for a total of 16 members.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann § 71-2-117(l)(2), non-legislative members of the Council do not receive compensation or reimbursement for any expenses incurred while participating in the business of the Council; therefore, any fiscal impact to state government is estimated to be not significant.
