HB 1838 – SB 1934

January 30, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits the adoption of an ordinance, resolution, regulation, code, or policy by a political subdivision which prohibits the connection or reconnection of a utility service based upon the type or source of energy to be provided to the individual customer.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:
