**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires at least one driver license testing station that conducts commercial driver license (CDL) tests to be located in each grand division.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- There are currently seven driver service centers that offer CDL Skills tests. They are: Chattanooga, Columbia, Cookeville, Jackson, Johnson City, Knoxville, and the Davidson County Driver Service Centers.
- Between these seven centers, there is at least one in each of the three grand divisions.
- This legislation will not result in an increase in state expenditures.
