SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from 30 to 45 days, the period of time before a disapproval order is effective after issuance by the Commissioner of the Department of Commerce and Insurance (DCI), if a policy form filed by a commercial risk insurer is deemed unlawful.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Increasing the period of time before a disapproval order becomes effective for a commercial risk insurer after issuance by the Commissioner of DCI will have no significant impact to existing policies or procedures of the Department.
- No significant impact to state or local government.
