FISCAL NOTE

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires county election commissions to designate restroom facilities in each building where an election is to be held that are for the use of campaign workers or volunteers. Prohibits a county election commission from prohibiting a campaign worker or volunteer from using the designated bathroom if the worker or volunteer covers or removes campaign clothing or accessories.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 2-7-111(a) and (b), any campaign materials, including buttons, caps, hats, pins, or shirts, are prohibited from entering the boundary established by county election commissions around designated entrances to buildings where an election is to be held.
- Requiring county election commissions to designate restroom facilities for the use of campaign workers or volunteers and authorizing use of the facilities if the worker or volunteer covers or removes campaign clothing or accessories will have no significant impact to polling place procedures.
- No significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
