SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires a jury coordinator to excuse a person age 70 years or older from jury duty upon written request, if provided documentation verifying the person's name, age, basis for making the request, and any other information required by the jury coordinator.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Any additional workload for the courts, as a result of this legislation, can be accommodated within existing resources and personnel.
- Requiring a person 70 years of age or older to be excused from jury duty upon request, if provided documentation, will not result in a significant increase to state or local expenditures.
