FISCAL NOTE

HB 2097 - SB 2740

February 18, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Attorney General and Reporter (AG) to submit notice of a lawsuit in which any state office, department, agency, board, commission, or instrumentality of this state becomes a party to that involves a question of state or federal constitutional law, or a controversy the subject of which exceeds \$1,000,000 to certain parties.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation requires the AG to submit notice of such lawsuits not less than 90 days after receiving notice or filing the law suit on behalf of the state entity to the following parties:
 - Governor;
 - Speaker of each House;
 - Chair of each relevant standing committee with subject matter jurisdiction over the state entity which is a party to the lawsuit or subject matter of the suit; and
 - Each member of the Judiciary Committee of the Senate and House of Representatives.
- Based on information provided by the AG, any additional duties resulting from the proposed legislation will be absorbed using existing resources.
