FISCAL NOTE

HB 2099 - SB 2285

February 13, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes any state regulatory board attached to the Division of Regulatory Boards under Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-3-1304, and any board, agency, or commission attached to the Division of Health Related Boards under Tenn. Code Ann. § 68-1-101 to conduct emergency meetings by teleconference when called by the presiding officer or upon petition by a majority of members if written notice is given to all members.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

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- The proposed legislation codifies current practice pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 8-44-108 regarding participation and reimbursement for participation by electronic means. It is assumed the proposed legislation will not result in a significant increase in teleconference usage; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all health related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Boards had an annual surplus of \$3,621,024 in FY17-18, an annual surplus of \$2,524,075 in FY18-19, and a cumulative reserve balance of \$36,189,376 on June 30, 2019.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all regulatory boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Boards had an annual surplus of \$2,476,154 in FY17-18, an annual surplus of \$2,141,317 in FY18-19, and a cumulative reserve balance of \$30,967,506 on June 30, 2019.
