FISCAL NOTE

HB 2105 - SB 2344

February 13, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Deletes language specifying the level of occupational training and technical education the state colleges of applied technology shall provide, and what kinds of students they are intended to serve.

Removes an obsolete requirement for the Tennessee Board of Regents (TBR) to restructure the Board and hire additional staff in order to carry out Public Chapter 181 of the Public Acts of 1983.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Deleting the language specifying the level and intended recipients of occupational training and technical education provided by the state colleges of applied technology will not substantially impact the policies or procedures of TBR or the state colleges of applied technology; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- TBR most recently underwent a major reconstruction as required by Public Chapter 869 of the Public Acts of 2016. Removing the prior restructuring requirement will not result in any significant fiscal impact to state government.
