HB 2148 – SB 2291

February 11, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Board for Licensing Contractors (BLC) to list the fee charged for reviewing and approving prelicensing general contractor education courses on its website.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The BLC currently lists the fee charged to review and approve general contractor education courses on its website; therefore, no significant impact to policies or procedures of the BLC.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all regulatory boards are required to be self-sufficient over any two-year period. The BLC experienced a surplus of \$96,912 in FY17-18, a surplus of \$81,710 in FY18-19, and had a cumulative reserve balance of \$2,594,876 on June 30, 2019.
- No significant fiscal impact to state or local government.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

Assumption:

- No significant impact to jobs or commerce in Tennessee.
