HB 2165 - SB 2418

February 18, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Expands the prohibitions regarding when a contractor or contractor's employee may not have direct contact with school children or with children in a child care program or enter school grounds or a child care center when children are present based on the length of time since a conviction or incarceration for a crime.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Department of Education (DOE), local education agencies (LEAs), and schools will be able to comply with the proposed legislation within existing resources.
- DOE, LEAs, and schools will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
